This document includes the ODF Paralympic Ice Sledge Hockey Data Dictionary. This document describes the differences between the Olympic Ice Hockey Data Dictionary and the Paralympic Ice Sledge Hockey Data Dictionary

1.2. Objective

The objective of this document is to provide a formal definition of the ODF Paralympic Ice Sledge Hockey Data Dictionary based in the ODF Olympic Ice Hockey Data Dictionary, with the intention that the information message producer and the message consumer can successfully interchange the information as the Ice Sledge Hockey competition is run.

1.3. Main Audience

The main audience of this document is the IOC as the ODF promoter, ODF users such as the World News Press Agencies, Rights Holding Broadcasters and International Sports Federations.
