1. Introduction

1.1. This document

This document includes the ODF **Para** Alpine Skiing Data Dictionary. This document describes the differences between the Olympic Alpine Skiing Data Dictionary and the Paralympic.

1.2. Objective

The objective of this document is to provide a formal definition of the ODF **Para** Alpine Skiing Data Dictionary based in the ODF Olympic Alpine Skiing Data Dictionary, with the intention that the information message producer and the message consumer can successfully interchange the information as the **Para** Alpine Skiing competition is run.

1.3. Main Audience

The main audience of this document is the IOC as the ODF promoter, ODF users such as the World News Press Agencies, Rights Holding Broadcasters and International Sports Federations.
